2nd Call for Posters

All students and researchers are invited to submit a poster for presentation at the 2nd Symposium on Participatory Research to Foster Innovation in Agriculture. We welcome posters which share research across all disciplines of agriculture related to participatory research. For consideration, abstracts must have been submitted no later than Friday 21st at 5 p.m. Poster presenters must be registered to attend the Symposium, and be registered by Friday 9th, for consideration.

Notifications of acceptance will be sent on 22nd August, 2019
Guidelines for Poster Preparation and Display

Time:

- Posters should be set up no earlier than 8am but prior to 9am on Wednesday, August 28th.
- Assigned post location will be available at check-in at registration, 1st Floor Lobby in the Hörsaal 2, Botanical Garden, Zurich, Switzerland. When registering, notify us of your poster title, and we will direct you to your assigned location.
- Posters should remain displayed through the end of the Closing Session on Thursday, August 29th. Please do not remove your poster before this time.
- **Posters should be taken down promptly after the Closing Session adjourns at 5:00pm. At 5:15pm, Thursday, August 29th any items remaining on display after that time will be removed and discarded.**

Display space and mounting requirements:

- Each individual poster board is made of corkboard and is fit for A0 size posters. Please bring a sufficient supply of push pins to affix your posters to the poster boards. These will also be available on-site, but in limited quantity.

Poster content:

All posters must include the title and information about the author(s), including name(s), affiliation(s), etc. Posters at 2nd Symposium on Participatory Research to Foster Innovation in Agriculture must address issues related to participatory research practices that enhance management and innovations. The poster should be focused and include the following:

1. Clear and concise title describing the content of the poster
2. An abstract that will summarize the main findings or message of the research
3. Clear objectives of the research or work presented in the poster

4. Materials and Methods address the research work in a concise and informative way
5. Results and discussions including figures and tables
6. Conclusions that summarize the main findings of the research

Project goals/objectives, methodology, results/findings, future work and other discussion should be presented in terms that can be understood by a technical audience. We strongly encourage the use of tables, photographs, diagrams, charts, and other graphics to help convey important information. There will be a poster contest and two posters will be selected for first place with monetary award of (CHF 100), second place for (CHF 75).

Judging criteria:

- Degree to which presenter demonstrates understanding of their subject matter.
- Clarity of description of presenter's research project, the scientific approach, and test results

Note that specific evaluation criteria are left to the judges' discretion. All decisions made by our team of judges are final.
